



*Dennis J. Brown Softball Scholarship
Administered through the Elizabethtown Area Education Foundation*

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide additional funds to a female who participates in interscholastic softball at Elizabethtown High School and wishes to continue playing softball at the intercollegiate level. The scholarship will be awarded based upon character, sportsmanship, integrity, and academic ability. To be eligible, you must

1. have been a member of the Elizabethtown Varsity softball program for two or more years;
2. be a member in good standing on the team and the school by never having been suspended from school(in grades 9-12), or dismissed from the team for any part of a season;
3. play on the Etown varsity during your senior year (exception may be made for a major injury that occurs preventing your from participating during year 12)
4. successfully try out for the intercollegiate softball team of her college (university) and be a member of that squad in good standing;
5. submit this application including an essay (see below) by March 15 of your senior year
6. have no more than 50% of yearly cost of tuition, room and board already covered by other scholarships
7. be available for an interview with the selection committee comprised of 2 or 3 members as appointed by the varsity head softball coach. This committee will include Dennis Brown as long as he chooses to be involved.

The value of the scholarship could be as much as \$2,000 over 4 years; payment of \$500 will be made by April of each year in which the student/athlete is participating in intercollegiate softball.
