EAEA Scholarships

1. The EAEA Scholarship(s) shall be made available only to graduating seniors of Elizabethtown Area High School.
2. Scholarships shall be granted only to students who have been accepted at accredited institutions.
3. Five (5) \$500 scholarships are awarded annually by the Elizabethtown Area Education Association and presented at the Senior Awards Night. The scholarship is based on outstanding academic achievement, leadership and service.
4. Every applicant must do the following:
 - A. Complete the application form and return it, along with a copy of your unofficial transcript, to Mr. Elicker, room 2640, at the high school. You can request an unofficial transcript from your guidance counselor.
 - B. Secure one (1) letter of recommendation from an individual who is familiar with your academic work, leadership roles and service commitments.
 - C. Applicants must furnish the person completing a recommendation with an envelope addressed to:
