The Elizabethtown Area Education Foundation (EAEF) seeks a graduating senior from Elizabethtown Area High School who will be attending an institution of higher learning and studying in a program leading to a health-related or physical education career. To be considered for the Jane Hoover Scholarship, in addition to providing evidence of acceptance to an institution of higher learning and enrolling in a health-related or physical education program, a student must demonstrate academic excellence and a financial need. The scholarship is in the amount of \$2,500 annually for up to four years provided the recipient maintains a minimum grade point average of 2.0. Scholarship monies will be issued to the institution at which the recipient is enrolled. Completed applications and written reference forms must be submitted by March 15 to the high school counseling office.
