## **THE BEVERLY GISH ULRICH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

There is hereby created by the Elizabethtown Area School District Education Foundation ("Foundation") the Beverly Gish Ulrich Memorial Scholarship which shall be administered in accordance with the terms and conditions herein after set forth or incorporated herein by reference.

### **GENERAL SCOPE**

The Beverly Gish Ulrich Memorial Scholarship is to be awarded to an Elizabethtown Area High School senior who has been accepted for post secondary study at an accredited institution with a teacher preparation major. The selected student will provide a minimum of a statement of intent to:

- a. major in the field of elementary education (first priority)
- or
- b. major in the field of secondary education

He/she must demonstrate high moral standards and integrity. Further, the student who is awarded the scholarship must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 through the first semester of his/her senior year. Given that an applicant has met all the criteria for eligibility, financial need should be given consideration in the final selection.

Beginning with the graduation class of 2007 the Beverly Gish Ulrich Memorial Scholarship will sponsor a \$1,000 scholarship to one recipient annually.

### **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

In addition to the considerations set forth above, the following terms shall apply:

1. There will be an application process for the scholarship. The application will include:
  - a. Demographic information.
  - b. The name of the college/university the student will attend.
  - c. A copy of the letter of acceptance with proof of the declared major from the college or a statement of intent indicating the major.
  - d. A list of extracurricular activities student participated in during high school.
  - e. A list of any awards, honors, or recognitions student received in high school.

- f. A list of any work/community service the student has performed in the past two years.
  - g. Estimated costs.
  - h. Two individuals who will provide an oral/written recommendation.
2. The High School Guidance Office will advertise the scholarship and verify the applicant is qualified to receive the scholarship.
  3. A committee of the Scholarship Foundation will screen and select the student to receive the scholarship based on the applications and the information therein.
  4. Academic achievement is a criteria but financial need should be given additional merit in the selection.
  5. The scholarship will be presented at the Senior Awards ceremony. A description of the award will be printed in the awards program.
  6. The payment of the scholarship fund allocation must be submitted directly to the post secondary institution the recipient will be attending.
  7. The Ulrich family will maintain \$10,000 in the scholarship account. The \$1,000 for the scholarship each year will come in total or in part from the earned interest. In the event the amount of interest earned by January 1 is less than \$500, the Ulrich family will receive a letter requesting the difference. The Ulrich family may donate additional funds to increase the scholarship principal at any time. Further, if the sum difference is not received, it will be taken from the scholarship principal. Should the family decide to discontinue the annual funding of the difference, the scholarship amount will be taken from interest and principal until the principal reaches no fund balance. At this time the scholarship will end.
  8. Except as set forth above, the terms, conditions, administration and award of the scholarship hereunder shall be set forth in the Standing Rules of the Foundation.

This scholarship was duly adopted by the action of the Board of Trustees of the Elizabethtown Area Education Foundation effective 2007.
