Guidelines for Invited Guests - EASD Athletic Events

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- Maintain a safe environment that respects the ongoing global health crisis **AND** adheres to the expectations of our board-approved Health and Safety Plan.
- Allows more parents/guardians the opportunity to see their child(ren) compete, perform, and/or cheer during the ongoing global health crisis.
- Maintains a crowd size where our safety measures are both manageable **AND** enforceable.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Invited guests (*see details below*) must symptom screen prior to arrival at our athletic venues. **STAY HOME** if you are displaying COVID-19 symptoms (*fever 100.4 or greater, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, chills, fatigue, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion, runny nose, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting*); awaiting results of a COVID-19 test; or been exposed to an individual with COVID-19.
- Designated seating areas, six feet apart, have been established in Daubert Gymnasium for invited guests.
- Invited guests **MUST** sit in one of the designated seating areas in pairs.
- Invited guests **MUST** remain in their seating area at all times. To ensure the health/safety of our invited guests, family units **MUST** sit in pairs only. Groups of three or more are **NOT PERMITTED** to sit in the same designated area.
- **PER THE GOVERNOR'S ORDER**, invited guests are required to wear a face covering at **ALL** times in Daubert Gymnasium.
- Invited guests must remain separate from the student-athletes at **ALL** times.
- Students can attend as an invited guest, if they have a ticket, but there will be **NO** student cheering sections at Daubert Gymnasium. As invited guests, students **MUST** sit with their parent/guardian.
- The concession stand **WILL NOT** be open at Daubert Gymnasium.
- **NO** food or drinks permitted inside Daubert Gymnasium.
- The District will **LIVE STREAM** ALL contests taking place in Daubert Gymnasium to serve as an alternative to in-person attendance. This includes varsity, junior varsity, and junior high contests.
- There will be **NO** invited guests from the opposing school at any of our home contests.

INVITED GUESTS (*persons holding a ticket*)

Basketball

- EASD-rostered athletes will be given two tickets for invited guests.
- **ALL** invited guests **MUST** sit in the bleachers in one of the designated seating areas in pairs.
- Invited guests of **JUNIOR HIGH** basketball players should park in the high school bus loop and enter through the designated entryway in the rear of the school building. Invited guests **MUST** immediately exit Daubert Gymnasium following the end of the game using the blue doors on the south baseline.
- Invited guests of **HIGH SCHOOL** basketball players should park in the high school main parking lot along East High Street and enter through the Daubert Gymnasium lobby doors. Invited guests **MUST** immediately exit Daubert Gymnasium following the end of the game using the same doors they entered through.

Wrestling

- EASD-rostered athletes will be given two tickets for invited guests.
- **ALL** invited guests **MUST** sit in the bleachers in one of the designated seating areas in pairs.
- Invited guests of **ALL** wrestlers (junior high and high school) should park in the high school main parking lot along East High Street and enter through the Daubert Gymnasium lobby doors. Invited guests **MUST** immediately exit Daubert Gymnasium following the end of the match using the same doors they entered through.

Swimming and Bowling

- Due to venue restrictions, unfortunately there will be **NO** invited guests for home or away swimming meets and bowling matches league-wide.
- Swimming meets and bowling matches will be **LIVE STREAMED** to the respective team's Facebook page when possible.

Guidelines for Invited Guests will be adjusted as new information is available. Details are subject to change.
