9.3 Establishing positive relationships within the school community across various backgrounds	Exhibits respect toward others by being courteous and helpful of persons with different handicaps, sex, and race. Consistently seeks to enrich oneself about people of other cultures. Consistently promotes pride in schools, individuals and in oneself.	Models positive attitudes. Encourages students, staff, and parents to work together frequently with an attitude of respect and cooperation.	Does not use and disallows negative comments.
