Take the challenge! Read by yourself, with your family, or with a friend! Read books, magazines, or other types of print! Keep track of what you read, and get your parents to initial your log. Everything you read will earn points. If you return your completed log to school no later than **August 29, 2019**, you will be treated to a "Summer Reading Challenge Root Beer Float Party" in the fall.

How can I earn points? READ! You will earn 1 point for each picture book, comic book, or magazine article and 5 points for each chapter book you read. You can earn points by reading a combination of picture books and chapter books. Just list your books on the attached log. Ask a parent to initial it after you tell him or her all about your book.

What are some ways I can read? You can read to your parents, a sibling, or you can read by yourself. **Parents can read to their children, too!** You can even read as a family or listen to audiobooks! Everything you read counts; just remember to record the information in the log.

How many points do I need to earn to meet the Challenge? In order to meet the Summer Reading Challenge and participate in the Root Beer Float Party, you need a total of **40 points**.

We all know how much fun reading is and how important it is to talk or write about what we have read. Take the Summer Reading Challenge! What will you read first?
