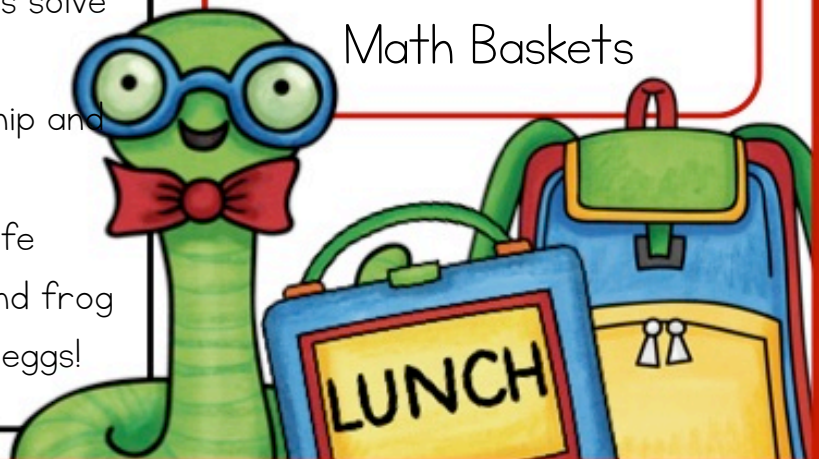
Our Learning

Reading- In September, we will work on summarizing, making connections, and categorizing and classifying.
