Immunization Requirements:

Student's immunization record must be provided at time of enrollment.

Proof of one of each of the required immunizations is required at the time of your child's registration appointment. The School Nurse will review the immunization record with you at time of enrollment. Required immunizations: tetanus, diphtheria, polio, measles, mumps, rubella (German Measles), hepatitis B and varicella or history of chicken pox disease.

Updated immunization records may be faxed, mailed or dropped off to either the school nurse or the student registration office.

These requirements allow for medical reasons and religious beliefs. **If your child is exempt from immunizations, he/she may be removed from school during an outbreak.**
